### Considerations, but not requirements:

- 1. Have demonstrated a willingness to make the time commitment involved by other similar type involvements.
- 2. Have demonstrated leadership in other similar activities.
- 3. Contributes to the diversity of the council as to practice area (policy holder v. carrier practice), regional diversity, in addition to the traditional diversity considerations.
